Grading

I have rubrics made up for summative projects so they know what they got on each project and why. It shows the main components I am looking for.

We have practice assignments, which are formative grades worth 20% of the overall grade, and summative grades, which are worth 80% of the overall grade.

The students have plenty of time during class to complete assignments. However if they are gone, it is their responsibility to make up the time they are behind. If it is a project they can take home and work on, that is acceptable, but if is not, then they have to use school time to catch up. There are deadlines, and due dates that have to be met as we move on to other projects.
