EXPECTATIONS:

CLASS PROCEDURE:

1. Students will come and sit down when bell rings. They will answer the daily question. They will then be instructed what to do by the instructor.
2. Notes will be taken on all discussions, guest speakers
3. All lab work and written assignments must be completed by due date.
4. Students will use correct terminology when talking about all machines, tools, and materials used in the shop.
5. Passes will be given to students if the instructor feels necessary. Students will make sure they bring all their materials with them to class and will have gone to the bathroom.

GRADING POLICY:

Grades will be based on a percentage basis. The percentages are as follows:

1. Summative 80%
Includes Lamp, pen holder, 6 safety test, and manufacturing test
2. Formative 20%
Includes daily questions and worksheets

For a student to be granted a retake, teacher approved remediation must have taken place. We may do the remediation during class study time, or lab. It is the student's responsibility to make arrangements for the retake.

CLASSROOM RULES:

14. Use appropriate language keep your filter in
15. Always use your head, this is the best way to avoid accidents.
16. Always clean up the lab before you leave.
17. Always follow the safety rules that have been discussed in class.
18. Failure to follow the rules in class could result in being dismissed from class.
