## What is KI-HIPP?

The Kentucky Integrated Health Insurance Premium Payment (KI-HIPP) program is a voluntary Medicaid program that helps families pay for employer-sponsored health insurance premiums. It is for families with at least 1 Medicaid member on the policy.

Note: Certain Medicaid programs, such as Kentucky Children's Health Insurance Program (KCHIP), are not eligible.

How can KI-HIPP benefit me?

- KI-HIPP pays a portion of the employer-sponsored health insurance premiums for the entire family.
- The Medicaid member does <u>NOT</u> lose their Medicaid benefits.
- The Medicaid member will have two insurances: employer health insurance (primary) and Medicaid (secondary).
- May allow an entire family to be on the same health insurance plan and access the same doctors.





## Am I eligible for KI-HIPP?

If you can answer "Yes" to these questions, you should apply:

- Does anyone in your family get Medicaid?
- Can someone in your family get health insurance at work?
