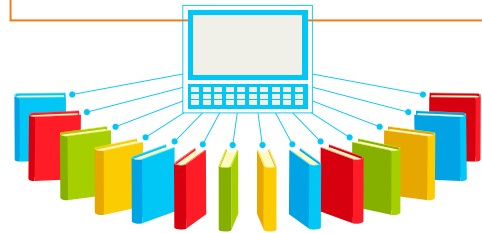
Fenton Area Public Schools, in collaboration with our community, is committed to educational excellence and to developing lifelong learners who are responsible citizens in a global society.

Fenton Area Public Schools will seek and deliver innovative and diverse curricula, instruction and assessments that grow the capacity of our students and staff.

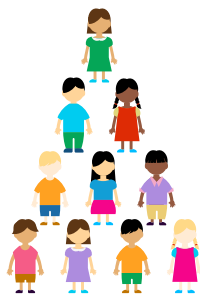
Fenton Area Public Schools will strengthen and build relationships within our school community and beyond.

FAPS will align its PK-12 curricular resources and assessments in the areas of ELA, math, social studies and science.

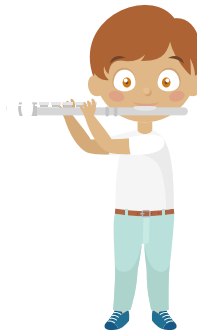

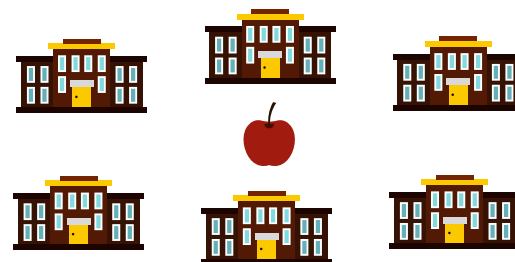


FAPS will use all available resources to showcase and market our school district as an exemplar district.

FAPS will foster positive partnerships with multiple community entities to strengthen our academic programs to support educating the whole child.



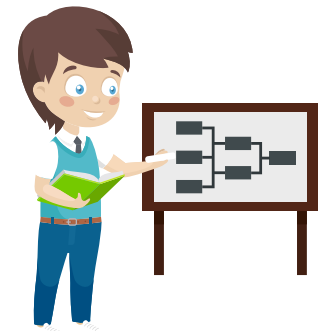
FAPS will develop a sense of unity among our six buildings, and across the school community, to enhance positive learning environments for our students.

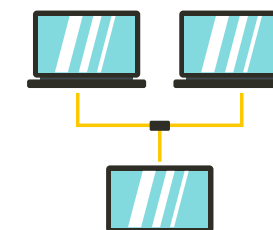
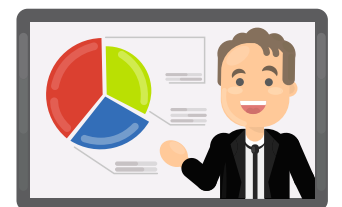
FAPS will promote and provide a safe and secure learning environment for all students and staff.
