**Named 2021 Hall of Fame  
Ambrose Award Winner**

**Brian Salyers** from Milford High School heads our Hall of Fame Inductees as the 2021 Kermit Ambrose Award recipient. The Ambrose Award is named after one of the MITCA Founding Fathers and is the highest honor given at the Cross Country Clinic. Brian has coached cross country at Milford since 1996. His coaching resume includes 6 State Championships, 19 Regionals Championships, and 17 League Titles. Brian has coached 58 All State Athletes (28 boys and 30 girls). He has been honored as MITCA Coach of the year 7 times (6 boys and one girls). In 2011 he was a NHSACA National Coach of the Year Finalist. His service to MITCA is also outstanding, 2018 - 2020 Cross Chair, 2007 – 2014 Team Michigan Head Coach.
