Eighth grade students at Westside High School will be enrolled in eight classes. Four classes will be academic core classes, such as English, Math, Science, and Social Studies. Two classes will be requested elective courses, and two will be required elective courses. Explanations of these courses have been provided.

Enhanced courses (formerly known as PreAP) are offered to 8th grade students in the subjects of English, Science, and Social Studies. Enhanced courses cover the same curriculum as regular 8th grade core courses, but Enhanced courses are designed to prepare students for higher intellectual engagement. In addition, summer work may be required for Enhanced courses. Summer work, if assigned by the teacher, will be posted to the school's website, www.westsideschools.org, by June 1st. Summer work must be completed by the student and submitted to the teacher by the deadline in order for students to remain in the Enhanced course. If the summer work is not completed and submitted on time, the student will be removed from the Enhanced course and placed in the regular education course of that subject.

All 8th grade students will take Math 8 during the 2022-2023 school year, unless the student is placed in a special education math course per their IEP. Algebra I will not be offered to 8th grade students.

Class schedules for 8th grade students with IEPs will be created based on the recommendations of the student's Special Education team. Special Education students are encouraged to complete a Course Request Form, but the finalized schedule will have to be approved by the appropriate stakeholders.

Elective Courses:

- 1. Introduction to World Agriculture
 - This is a foundation course for agriculture courses. Basic agriculture concepts are introduced, and students explore careers in the agriculture industry. Students will also be introduced to the FFA, leadership, and Supervised Agricultural Experiences.

2. Introduction to Spanish Language and Culture

 This is a foundation course for learning the Spanish language. Students will be introduced to the basics of communication, structure, and culture of the Spanish-speaking world.

3. EAST

- Environmental and Spatial Technology (EAST) is a student-driven learning environment. Students will learn how to use state of the art technology and help solve problems within the school and community.
- 4. Student Council (must be an elected member)
- 5. Boys Athletics (Football and/or Basketball, must be a member of the team)
- 6. Girls Athletics (Volleyball and/or Basketball, must be a member of the team)
- 7. Cheerleading (must be a member of the squad)
- 8. Band
- 9. Choir
- 10. Art Elective 8
- 11. Computer Science Elective 8
- 12. Study Hall (will be assigned only if no other elective courses are available)

Required Electives:

- 1. Rotation Classes Classes will change every quarter. Students will take P.E., Health, Art, and Music throughout the school year.
- 2. Keyboarding (semester) Students will learn basic computer/keyboarding skills that will help them with their day-to-day Chromebook use.
- 3. Tools for Learning (semester) This class is a study skills class for all 8th grade students.
