## **Immunizations**

Parents are reminded that immunizations need to be completed this summer. We will not be able to enroll your child next fall unless their shot record is up-to-date.

## **First Day of Class – August 15**

The first day of classes for the next school year is Thursday, August 15, 2018. The school day for all students will begin at 8:05 am and end at 3:20 pm. Breakfast will begin serving at 7:45 am and be dismissed at 8:00 am. Students must be in class by 8:10 am or they will be counted tardy.

## **2018-2019 Kindergarten Students**

Children in the Calumet School District who will be five (5) years of age as of September 1, 2018, are eligible to attend Calumet School's Kindergarten program. If your child did not attend Calumet Schools the last school year pre-enrollment is encouraged. Parents need to contact Calumet School at 893-2222. Parents should have the child's birth certificate, an up-to-date shot record, and social security number to complete enrollment.

## **Summer School**

Summer School will be Monday – Thursday, beginning June 4 – June 28, from 8:30 – 11:30 am each week. Classes will be at the elementary school this summer. Teachers have already referred their students that they feel would benefit from summer school this year. Students also will need to accompany their parents to get a class schedule and locker. On August 2, 2018, from 9:00am – 12:00pm. It is very important that we have parent contact information, for this is how we send out school messages.
