- It is preferred to have a design that is in a digital format, but students may submit artwork.

A simple search of "bicentennial logos" will give ideas of what is expected.

I recommend that our art classes and/or other classes consider promoting our students to participate. Adults are also welcomed to submit an entry if he/she wishes.

Finally, **ENTRIES ARE DUE BY DECEMBER 10TH**. If a school has numerous entries, I recommend that the "top 5" be submitted from each school. Be sure to include the designer's name and contact information with the submission. I will accept all entries from school-related personnel or from students. Anyone not affiliated with Lawrence County Schools should submit his/her entry directly to Vince Doty at the County Judge's office
