The following goals are seeking approval from September 2021 to June of 2023.

2021-2023 Board Goals

- 1) By June of 2023, student progress, academic growth, and social-emotional learning will be supported from both the student and faculty perspective by supporting the implementation of effective programs that will develop teaching and learning as indicated by the quality of student work and positive outcomes.
- 2) By June of 2023, the board will support the Superintendent and School Business Administrator in an analysis for and implementation of a five-year financial plan.
- 3) By June of 2023, the board will design a facilities and funding plan to address the needs of the district's physical plant. The plan will outline expected projects that will need consideration in the next ten years of budgeting and planning.

2021-2023 District Goals

- 1) By September of 2022, the curricular core of Ringwood's Programs will be in alignment to the New Jersey's Student Learning Standards revisions from June 2020. The subjects addressed in September 2021* are Science, Visual and Performing Arts, World Languages, and K-3 Career Readiness, Life Literacies, and Key Skills. The subject area timeline for September 2022 are Comprehensive Health and Physical Education, Social Studies, Computer Science and Design Thinking, and K-8 Career Readiness, Life Literacies, and Key Skills. The Atlas curriculum mapping software will remain Ringwood's dynamic curriculum repository.
- 2) By June of 2023, the K-8 Mathematics Program will employ an inquiry-based approach to teaching and learning. This transition entails a continued commitment to teacher training and a wide range of classroom and professional resources. This work is supported by two professional development entities, Savvas and Conquer Math. The five-year mathematics plan:
 - i. Year 1* – 2019-2020 - Exploration of resources and preliminary training
 - ii. Year 2* – 2020-2021 - Deployment of Investigations K-5 with PD
 - iii. Year 3 – 2021-2022 -Continued PD at all grade levels K-8 Deployment of Connected Math (CMP3) in Grades 6 & 7
 - iv. Year 4 – 2022-2023 Deploy CMP3 in Grade 8 as well as Algebra and Geometry solutions and Continue years 1&2 of PD on all necessary grade levels
 - v. Year 5 – 2023-2024 - Complete year 2 of Conquer Math PD for all grade levels requiring year 2 training
 - vi. 2024+ Train new staff as necessary, and update PD, “sharpen the saw”
- 3) By June of 2022 complete the NJQSAC process for the AY2022-2023 Passaic County Cohort 3 evaluation. If this formal process does not occur by legislative order, self-evaluation will meet this goal. This inspection evaluates Ringwood's compliance in the monitored categories of Instruction and Program, Fiscal Management, Governance, Operations, and Personnel.
