# What is an Academy Program?

A full-time, comprehensive high school program with a focus on Career and Technical Education (CTE) classes in their respective career area. Part-time programs are also available.

- Currently 19 Academy Programs within the Morris County Vocational School District
  - 11 stationed at the Denville Campus
  - o 8 satellite programs (Randolph, Jefferson, Madison, Morris Hills, Morris Knolls, Roxbury)
- Students across Morris County can apply
  - Competitive application process including the review of grades, recommendations, personal video submission, and an admissions test
  - Deadline to submit all application materials is December 10, 2021
  - Decisions made in late January to early February
- Accepted students become full time Madison High School students
  - Earn a Morris County Vocational School District Diploma

# Why Develop an Academy Program?

- Benefits for Madison High School
  - Creates new programs to provide new opportunities for students
  - Enhances current programs and supports for students
  - Expands and grows the Senior Internship Program
  - Increases revenue to further improve programs and add staffing
- Madison Student Participation in MCVSD Academies
  - o 27 Madison students currently attend a full-time Academy program at another school
  - 5 Madison High School students participate in a shared time program
  - Cost to the Madison School District Approximately \$400,000 (including transportation)
