

INTERNET PRIVACY

The Goochland County School Board is committed to complying with the Government Data Collection and Dissemination Practices Act and the Virginia Freedom of Information Act. The Goochland County School Board does not collect unnecessary personal information by means of its website and other third-party websites used as part of contractual services with the Goochland County Public Schools, and collects only appropriate personal information to the extent necessary to serve its constituents and the community. Examples of third-party websites include PowerSchool, Schoology, Seesaw, eCollect, and Edgenuity.

Goochland County School Board collects the following information through its website: Occasionally, Goochland County School Board offers a commenting feature or a web-based form to collect information as part of its website. These forms collect the information you provide, in addition to an IP address and timestamp. There is no requirement to complete these forms or participate in comments. Third party services and websites used by the Goochland County Public Schools will also collect information provided by you, such as username, email address, or other information you provide.

The following information is collected automatically by accessing the website: IP address and browser information (version of web browser and platform).

Our website and those created by service providers to Goochland County Public Schools may place “cookies” on your computer unless your browser is set to reject cookies. The cookies enable those who update our website content to recognize users when they return to the website at a later date or time so they can more easily login to our website. Third party websites may use cookies to remember users who return to their websites and include usernames to facilitate logging in. Cookie information placed on a computer by this website includes the following: username.

Information collected through the division’s website is used as follows: If you leave comments on our website or use forms that collect responses, the IP address is captured, along with any information you provide. Visitors to our website and third-party websites may also have their IP address and specific analytics about your computing device recorded to help us improve the usability of our website. IP addresses do not reveal a user’s identity, but can be cross-referenced to indicate your internet service provider and internet service provider’s location. Some of this information can also be used in an investigation of fraud or stolen identity.

The Superintendent is responsible for creating and updating, as necessary, an internet privacy policy statement. The statement is available on the division’s website in a conspicuous manner.
