

Starting this month, we will be showing a monthly thought-provoking documentary. Join us on July 18th at 1pm as we screen Sian-Pierre Regis' documentary "Duty Free".

After a 75 year-old immigrant mother gets fired without cause from her lifelong job as a hotel housekeeper, her son takes her on a bucket-list adventure to reclaim her life. As she struggles to find work, he documents a journey that uncovers the economic insecurity shaping not only her future, but that of an entire generation.

Duty Free examines ageism, the care crisis, and economic insecurity in America. Who will care for and support our moms and dads? Our grandmothers and our grandfathers? Who will support us as we age?

We are working on hosting a Zoom meet & Greet with the Director and his mom and hope to have more info about that soon! In the meantime, make sure to come watch this documentary!
