SELECTION PROCESS

The Anson Jones Chapter of National Honor Society offers membership based on a student's application and outstanding performance in the areas of scholarship, service, leadership, and character. The NHS Faculty Council selects the students for induction based on the following criteria for the nominee:

- 1. Be a junior or senior at Anson High School.
- 2. Have a cumulative grade average of 90.0 or above.
- 3. Have passed all sections of the EOC exams.
- Have demonstrated high standards of honesty, reliability, and respect for others. Students may be denied membership based on documentation of unlawful behavior or school disciplinary action.
- 5. Have been enrolled in Anson High School for at least one full semester prior to application.
- 6. Document their participation, leadership, and service in school and community activities on the application form.
- 7. Obtain signatures or initials from the teacher/adult in charge of each activity in which the student participated.
- 8. Those students selected for membership in NHS must sign a Code of Conduct and a Contract, promising to fulfill all responsibilities in order to maintain their membership in the organization. Copies of the Code of Conduct and the Contract have been attached. If the student chooses NOT to sign these documents, the invitation for membership will be considered null and void.
