AMI Plan

Marshall School District has worked through a process as approved by DESE to develop an Alternative Method of Instruction (AMI) plan to be utilized in the event that school is closed due to inclement weather or other emergency circumstances for up to 36 hours of attendance. Please review the information below about the plan.

Expectations for Students and Teachers:

- Students at all levels will complete the assigned work given to students during the event of a foreclosure and the AMI plan implemented.
- Teachers will send and communicate with students and parents/guardians on assignments.
- Parents should ensure that their students are completing the daily work. They should also monitor student assignments and the turning in of assignments that were sent home.
- Parents/guardians should contact their student's teacher with any questions they may have regarding assignments. If parents/guardians are unable to contact the teacher and need assistance, they should contact the building principal.

To count attendance, students need to submit assignments upon the return to school. If assignments are not submitted with the timeframe communicated by the building, the student will be counted absent as communicated to the office.
