# Franklin Schools updates:

- Covid is still impacting staff and students; staff stretched thin
- End of year celebrations scheduled for transitions
- Prom was May 14 and was well attended
- Over 50 students attended Chem Free, which was supported by the SAP grant, Mayor's Drug
  Task Force and community donations. There were 8 brave volunteers who stayed up all night to
  supervise the laser tag, movies, games.

# **Grants Updates:**

- Promising Futures Grant/ SAP
  - both will be closing out at the end of June 2022
  - SAP may have another round of funding offered
  - Promising Futures through DOE will NOT be available to Franklin schools due to its past relationship; they want to support schools who have not already received funds through DOE
- **STOP Grant**: Current grant is piloting <u>NABITA</u> threat assessment tools to prepare for training and widespread use throughout the district next year
- STOP (part 2) APPLICATION: we will be applying for a round of funding (due June 20, 2022) to support PREVENTION of school safety incidents. Focus will be on building districtwide capacity for MTSSB.
