On November 19, 2021, Jefferson-Lewis BOCES received confirmation from Jefferson County Public Health that three (3) students at the Bohlen Technical Center have tested positive for COVID-19.

On November 19, 2021, Jefferson-Lewis BOCES received confirmation from Lewis County Public Health that a student at the Sackett Technical Center has tested positive for COVID-19.
