June 23, 2021

Tuesday, June 22, 2021, President G. Allen Crist called the regular meeting of the River Ridge Community Unit School District #210 Board of Education to order at 6:30 pm. Board Members G. Allen Crist, Amy Finn, Barb Schaible, Raymie Diestelmeier, Diane Haring and Lisa Walters answered roll call. Member McLane was absent. President Crist announced a quorum was established. Also present: Superintendent Brad Albrecht, Principal Beau Buchs, Principal Mike Foltz, a representative for the RREA and community members.

Approved the June agenda as presented.

Approved the regular and executive session board meeting minutes of May 17, 2021 and destruction of audio executive session minutes from September 16, 2019.

Reviewed the Treasurer’s Report, Investment Report and Activity Reports. Approved bills and payroll as presented in the amount of \$754,013.54.

Supt. Albrecht reported on the CTE (Jo Daviess Carroll Technical Education Academy) minutes from June 7, 2021. Little Learners Academy has 25 children and the Galena Rotary grant for \$2,500 was received and will be used for outdoor activities.

Administrative Reports:

Track and Field Day and Elementary Awards were held on May 27th.

62 students are signed up for summer school.

High school graduation went very well.

Kudos to the entire staff for completing a very challenging 20-21 school year.

ESSR monies update.

Approved the purchase of elementary Math series, 6-12 Math series, 6-8 World History and Environmental Science textbooks. ESSR money will be used to purchase these textbooks.

Appointed District Superintendent Fox to review, accept and sign-off on the financial statements of the District which include the audit report, the annual financial report to the state and the Data Collection Form (for single audits only) on behalf of the River Ridge School District #210 for the fiscal year and to sign the transmittal letter for River Ridge auditors, Benning Group.

Adopted the Resolution to Establish Fund Balance Policy GASB 54 #R2011-01 and Resolution for Commitment of Funds Policy GASB 54 #R2011-02.

Approved registration, lunch, breakfast and milk money to remain the same as 2020-2021.

Approved Athletic Field Services to do the track repairs in the amount of \$108,000.
