1. How long do I have to sign up for Benefits after I am hired?

You have 29 days from your Benefits Eligible Appointment Date to sign up for benefits.

2. How long are my children eligible for benefit coverage?

Eligible dependents children will have coverage until the end of their 26th birthday month. Premiums will continue to be deducted until the end of the month.

3. I have recently married. What do I have to do to change benefits?

You will need to contact State Health Benefit Plan and the Benefits Support Center to add a spouse or any new dependents to your policy. Documentation is required to make this change.

5. When is the next Open Enrollment period for active full-time employees?

Open Enrollment is typically in October/November for an effective date of January 1st.

6. Can I change my elections after the enrollment period has ended?

No, you may not make changes to your benefit elections after your enrollment cycle has ended. The only time you are allowed to make changes is when you experience a qualified change in family status (sometimes called a "life event"), which include:

- Marriage or divorce
- Death of a dependent child or spouse
- Change in your or your spouse's employment status that results in the loss or gain of coverage
- Birth, adoption, or change in the custody of your child
- A change in your dependent's eligibility due to marriage, age, or loss of dependent status for federal tax purposes
- Your changes must correspond with the life event; for example, when you get
 married you can add your spouse to your medical plan, but you can't suddenly enroll
 yourself in the dental plan.

7. When will my benefits become effective?

Coverage is effective the first of the month after a full calendar month of employment.

Example: Hire date 07-01-2022 coverage effective 08-01-2022

Example: Hire date 07-19-2022 coverage effective 09-01-2022

8. Where do I need to add my dependents for benefits?

When you enroll for your benefits, include dependents who need coverage and choose a beneficiary(ies) if you participate in a life insurance, AD&D or a retirement plan.

9. When are the premiums for benefits deducted from my paycheck?

Benefits are paid one month prior to the coverage effective date.

Example one: Hire date 07-01-2022 coverage effective 08-01-2022 therefore deductions are taken from your July paycheck(s).

If payroll deadline occurs before, double deductions will be taken from your August paycheck(s).

Example two: Hire date 07-19-2022 coverage effective 09-01-2022 therefore deductions are taken from your August paycheck(s). If payroll deadline occurs before, double deductions will be taken from your September paycheck(s).
