Dear Parent/Guardian:

The Iowa County Health Department is working with your school district to provide COVID-19 vaccine to students aged 5-11 this fall. The Pfizer COVID-19 vaccine has received approval by the FDA and is currently under review by the CDC. As we await final approval from the CDC and WI Department of Health Services, we are working with your child's school to plan a vaccine clinic for students in this 5-11 age group. Your school will notify you of the date of the vaccine clinic once the schedule has been confirmed.

- The Pfizer vaccine is **FREE** for all students, no insurance information is needed
- The Pfizer vaccine is injectable

If you would like to have your child vaccinated at school, please do the following:

1. **Read** the attached *ICHD COVID-19 Vaccines – Parent FAQ's*
2. **Read** the attached *Vaccine Information Fact Sheet*
3. **Complete** the Vaccine Administration Record And Screening Form (Consent Form)
4. **Return** the Consent Form to the school by November 8th.

There is no need to return the form if you do not want to participate in the COVID-19 vaccine clinic.
