Greene County Community School District Special Meeting/Work Session July 15, 2020

The Greene County Community School District Board of Directors held a work session on July 15, 2020 in the Administrative Building Conference Room. President Steve Fisher called the meeting to order at 5:15 p.m. Directors Steve Karber, John McConnell and Catherine Wilson; Superintendent Tim Christensen and Board Secretary Brenda Muir were all present. Due to COVID-19 concerns, seating was limited and the meeting was live streamed for public access. Director Mike Dennhardt arrived after approval of the agenda.

Karber made and Wilson seconded a motion to approve the agenda as presented. Motion carried 4-0.

The Middle School building was the topic of discussion for the work session.

Nate Adams, a developer, presented his plan to convert the building to a 25 unit apartment building with studio, 2 bedroom and 3 bedroom units. It would be part of the Vision 2020 plan for a three block project. He has no interest in the gym attached to the building. That section would be torn down under his plan.

Jeramie Hinote, owner of Play 4 Him Academy, presented his idea to acquire the gym for youth sports programs use. He would have no interest in the 3 story building. The board suggested he look into development costs and funding sources.

The future of the building will be decided at a future board meeting.

Owner's Representative Sam Harding updated the board on the new High School/Career Academy construction progress. The academic wing is still on track for an August 1, 2020 district acceptance. The gym and auditorium may be delayed slightly.
