

Greene County Community School District
Special Meeting/Work Session
August 19, 2020

The Greene County Community School District Board of Directors held a work session on August 19, 2020 in the Administrative Building Conference Room. President Steve Fisher called the meeting to order at 5:15 p.m. Directors Mike Dennhardt, John McConnell and Catherine Wilson; Superintendent Tim Christensen and Board Secretary Brenda Muir were all present. Due to COVID-19 concerns, seating was limited and the meeting was live streamed for public access. Director Steve Karber arrived after roll was called.

McConnell made and Dennhardt seconded a motion to approve the agenda as presented. Motion carried 5-0.

Owner's Representative Sam Harding updated the board on the construction projects. Completion is very near for the High School academic wing and the Career Academy.
