Finally, I would like to wish all of you a healthy, relaxing, and safe Thanksgiving break!





Counselor's Corner- Mrs. Garvey

Research suggests that attending school regularly is important to ensuring children develop a strong foundation for subsequent learning. The early elementary years are crucial. Children are gaining basic social skills critical to ongoing academic success. Here are some tips for getting your child to school every day on time.

- 1. Make sure that your child reports to school each day on time and only takes days off when it is absolutely necessary.
- 2. Schedule appointments after school or on days that school is closed.
- 3. Do not schedule family trips or vacations during school days. Consider planning those trips during winter or spring break.
- 4. Consider flu vaccinations for your children.
