

Student Contract to Ride the Bus

While riding a school bus, students will obey and follow rules set by the driver at all times; use assigned seats, and follow the directions of coaches, teachers, and chaperones who are responsible for maintaining order on trips.

Students will:

1. Obey the driver at all times;
2. Accept assigned seats;
3. Talking will be done in quiet voices;
4. Not throw objects, in bus or out of the bus windows;
5. Not fight, wrestle or scuffle;
6. Not stand up and/or move from seats while the bus is in motion;
7. Not extend hands, head, feet or objects from windows or doors;
8. Not possess matches or other incendiaries and concussion devices;
9. Not block aisles and passageways;
10. Use emergency exits only as directed by the driver;
11. Not damage school property or the personal property of others;
12. Not threaten or physically harm the driver or other riders;
13. Not do any disruptive activity which might cause the driver to stop in order to reestablish order;
14. Not make disrespectful or obscene statements;
15. Not have in their possession any weapon as defined by Board policy JFCJ, Weapons in the schools;
16. Not possess and/or use tobacco, alcohol or illegal drugs;
17. Not carry glass containers or other glass objects;
18. Not possess air or helium filled balloons
19. Answer to coaches, teachers and chaperons who are responsible for maintaining order on trips.
20. No animals except for properly licensed service animals

Students at bus stops and waiting at school will:

1. Stay 12-15 feet away from the bus when it is moving;
2. Be at the bus stop five minutes before the scheduled pick-up time (schedules will be posted on all buses and website.)

Students breaking these rules are subject to district disciplinary measures up to and including the denial of participating in district provided transportation.
