Minutes

President Marshall called the Special Meeting to order at 6:30pm and led those present in the Pledge of Allegiance

The Board reviewed the Agenda for November 22, 2021 and found it to be correct.

Mr. Seifried informed the Board of a quote he had received to install new LED signage on the bus that has been ordered. The Board discussed price (\$1455.00 in addition to the current price of the bus); delivery deadline (will still be on time); affordability (with the trade-in value from the last bus, the new bus would still be under budget); location of the lights (above the front windshield and above the emergency exit on the rear); the possibility of additional lights being put on the stop sign (the cost of which will be looked into and presented at the next meeting); the impact on visibility for the driver (there is a shield so no impact); and whether it would be worth the cost to retro fit these lights on busses we currently have (the cost of the installation versus the value of the busses will be looked into).

No decisions were made, Mr. Seifried will bring further information to the next board meeting on December 6, 2021.

Mr. Seifried reviewed the Unpaid County Tax Report. Trustee Mower asked what happens if the taxes continue to be unpaid. Mr. Seifried explained that any unpaid school tax is recovered from the county which in turn adds the tax onto the individuals property tax and keeps track of that from there forward. This means that the school collects their allotted taxes no matter what.
