WELLNESS FOR STUDENTS AND STAFF

I. PURPOSE

This regulation implements Policy ADF and provides guidelines for a district Wellness Policy Leadership Committee.

II. DEFINITIONS

1. “WPCL” means the Wellness Policy Leadership Committee.

III. GUIDELINES

- A. The Wellness Policy Leadership Committee (WPLC) represents all areas of coordinated school health including: nutrition, physical education and activity, health education and life skills, staff wellness, family, school and community partnerships, healthy and safe environment, social and emotional well-being, and health services. These will include district personnel, school site members, students, parents, and members of the community.
- B. The WPLC will meet a minimum of two times during the school year.
- C. WPLC is responsible for the goals that are set, reviewed and evaluated annually for coordinated school health.
- D. The school principal is responsible for providing input, feedback, and data to the WPLC and will implement, with district support, the established wellness policy goals. Progress will be monitored during the principal mid-year and final review of goals under the Domains of Instruction and Operations Management.
- E. WPLC will review the site assessments to determine progress and set the following school year’s goals.
- F. The triennial assessment procedures will determine:
 - a. compliance with the wellness policy;
 - b. how the wellness policy compared to model wellness policies;
 - c. progress made in obtaining the goals of the wellness policy.
- G. Annual and triennial reports, made by individual sites, will be made public through the LCPS website. Wellness policies shall also be made public via the district’s website. The results shall be presented to the District Advisory Council.

IV. REVIEW

This regulation shall be reviewed on an ongoing basis in accordance with the Board of Education policy review process.
