

H. NEW BUSINESS

1. District and Schools Strategic Plan Alignment Presentation

Assistant Superintendent, Jo-Ann Sexton reviewed the District Strategic plan. High School Principal, Mr. Daniel Sweeney; Tioughnioga Riverside Academy Principal, Mr. John Whalen; and Caryl E. Adams Primary School Principal, Mrs. Jo-Anne Knapp discussed their Building Strategic Plans.

Ms. Sexton gave a presentation on the District Strategic Plan with details on the various tenets. She outlined the key initiatives of the Whitney Point School District and noted how progress will be measured.

Mr. Sweeney discussed the 2019-2020 High School Academic Improvement Plan. He stated the High School is focusing on a number of areas with subcommittees working on chronic absenteeism, student support, and the master schedule.

Mrs. Knapp briefly discussed the 2019-2020 Academic Improvement Plan for the Caryl E. Adams Primary School. She noted how the improvement work in the CEA is aligned with the District Strategic.

Mr. Whalen discussed the Tioughnioga Riverside Academy 2019-2020 Academic Improvement Plan. He stated he is looking at classroom culture and modeling the use of circles, and focusing on a relational approach to students. He stated they are utilizing teacher-led committees as they work on ways to improve the school.

Thomas Tasber expressed concern about 3-8 ELA scores and particularly the performance of students with disabilities.

A discussion ensued.

J. SUPERINTENDENT'S UPDATE

- Vacant Board of Education Seat Ms. Follette stated Ms. Champney took the Board's recommendation at the last meeting and contacted some people to fill the vacant seat. She stated Mr. Maslin graciously agreed to fill the seat until the election next May.
- Construction Management RFP Update Ms. Follette stated this project will be around \$27 million dollars and will include a multi-purpose turf field. She stated there was a detailed RFP sent to seven qualified firms. Hubert Engineering, Tamco, Wurth, and Turner Construction all submitted proposals. She discussed the different aspects for each. She stated they will be conducting interviews and will report back at the next Board of Education Meeting.

- Safety Plan Update Ms. Follette stated there is a new Safety Plan Procedure implemented through State Ed. She stated they have new requirements so we will be holding a Safety Plan Hearing at the beginning of the December 10, 2019 Board of Education Meeting.
- Community Foundation Fund Ms. Follette stated this fund should be in place soon.

Mrs. Champney stated at the BOCES President/Vice-President Meeting she was informed that community members will be receiving a census form, which they will need to complete. She suggested the District or the library hold a census completion night to assist community members.

Dr. Widdall asked how the band field trip was funded and if all students could attend if they couldn't afford to pay for it.

Mrs. Champney stated the field trip is funded through fundraising by the Music Booster's Club, and yes the students can still attend.
