SUBJECT: EXECUTION OF POLICY: ADMINISTRATIVE REGULATIONS

The Board shall delegate to the Superintendent the function of specifying required actions and designing the detailed arrangements under which the schools will operate. These rules and these detailed arrangements shall constitute the administrative regulations governing the schools. They must be consistent with the policies adopted by the Board. In the absence of applicable policy, the Superintendent is authorized to establish needed regulations subject to later confirmation in policy, should the Board so wish. The Board does not under normal circumstances adopt administrative regulations unless specifically required to do so by law, or unless requested to do so by the Superintendent, or as required by negotiated agreements with employee organizations, in which case, any such regulation shall become a part of any such agreement and shall be subject to amendment as provided in any such agreement. Adoption and amendment of such Board adopted regulations shall be by the same procedure as that specified for policies.
