SUBJECT: SPECIAL MEETINGS OF THE BOARD OF EDUCATION

Special meetings of the Board shall be held on call by any member of the Board. Such call shall be evidence by a notice specifying the purpose, time and place of the meeting. Twenty-four hour notice shall be given where practical to members by the Superintendent or the Board President, as the case may be and shall indicate the matter to receive attention.

Public notice of time and place of the special meeting shall be given "to the extent practical to the public and news media at a reasonable time prior to the meeting."
