

Code of Conduct for Spectators

- 1. Spectators are an important part of the games and are encouraged to conform to accepted standards of good and behavior.
- 2. Spectators should at all times respect players, coaches, officials, cheerleaders and guest in the community and extend all courtesy to them.
- 3. Positive cheering for one's team and opposing team is encouraged.
- 4. During a free throw is should be quiet and all courtesies should be extended.
- 5. Booing, whistling, stamping of feet and disrespectful remarks will not be permitted.
- 6. There will be no ringing of bells, sounding of horns or other noise makers at contests.
- 7. The throwing of debris, confetti or other objects is prohibited.
- 8. There is no use of drugs, alcohol and tobacco products on school property.
- 9. Individuals under the influence are not permitted to attend school contests.
- 10. Students cannot leave the building and re-enter the contests.
- 11. Please avoid eating in the gym and clean up all trash in the bleachers.
- 12. Spectators should encourage each other to observe courteous behavior. improper behavior should be reported to school authorities.
- 13. Spectators will respect and obey all school official and supervisors at athletic contests.
- 14. Anyone who does not abide by the rules will be asked to leave the premises.
