Student Application for Driving/Riding Privileges



The following regulations regarding student vehicles on school property will be strictly enforced at all times. The term vehicle includes automobiles, trucks, motorcycles, etc.

Students **MUST** submit a completed application for parking privileges at the start of every school year in which they are planning to park their vehicle in the school parking lot. Permission is **NOT** carried over from school year to school year.

Students driving to school must adhere to the following regulations:

- 1) Vehicles must be registered with the High School Office. The student driver must affix the appropriate parking pass to their vehicle on the rear passenger window on the driver's side. The parking sticker is assigned to the student for their high school career.
- 2) The designated parking area for student drivers is the far east parking lot next to the soccer field. All other school parking lots are designated for employee and visitor parking only.
- 3) Students are allowed to go out to the Student Lot during the school day with permission, to retrieve an item, ONCE during the school year. At this time the student MUST sign out and back in at the high school office before returning to class.
- 4) Students who arrive late to school must park in the student parking lot. Students who are dismissed early from school are required to leave their vehicles in the student parking lot during the day. Permission to park in any other parking area requires the prior permission of the HS principal.
- 5) All students will observe the 10 M.P.H. speed limit and are expected to use caution while entering and leaving the parking lot.
- 6) Student drivers must drive in a safe manner at all times.
- 7) Student drivers need to keep their vehicles locked at all times. York Central School is not responsible for the loss of any valuables taken from, or damage to, any student vehicles parked on our grounds.

In the case of vehicular accidents on school property, the police will be called to investigate.

CONSEQUENCES OF DRIVING VIOLATIONS

1st Referral: 2 weeks of suspension of driving privileges 2nd Referral: 4 weeks of suspension of driving privileges

3rd Referral: Termination of driving privileges for the remainder of the school year

CONSEQUENCES OF PARKING VIOLATIONS

1st Referral: Warning sticker affixed to the window of the automobile. 2 weeks suspension of driving privileges plus moving of vehicle to student lot. License plate number recorded by the School Resource Officer and kept on record for future violations.

2nd Referral: Student vehicle may be towed at the expense of the student. 4 weeks suspension of driving privileges.

3rd Referral: Termination of driving privileges for the remainder of the current school year.

CONSEQUENCES OF LATENESS

1st Offense: After 3 illegal latenesses, there will be a loss of driving privileges for 5 weeks.

2nd Offense: Loss of driving privileges for an additional 5 weeks for each additional set of 3 latenesses.

CONSEQUENCES FOR TAKING PASSENGERS TO BOCES

The student driver will lose all driving privileges to BOCES and the driver and all passengers will receive an assignment to extended detention.

York Central School reserves the right to search student vehicles based on reasonable suspicion of a vehicle containing materials that are illegal to possess, or items that present possible safety problems for members of our school community. See YCS Code of Conduct for clarification.
