 - Pool will be open the first of the year.
 - Starting students of the month – will choose a monthly character trait and involve the kids in choosing recipient.
 - Kevin Dinning (Secondary)
 - As far as State funding, he's happy our enrollment is going up.
 - Feels we are in a really good place with staff. Several districts are still trying to fill open positions. We also have great substitutes, and we will support classified people that want to get certified.
