Budget Committee Minutes

The meeting was called to order at 6:03 pm by Board Chair Rob Crum.

Election of Chair and Vice Chair

Tim Holtz nominated Joel Peterson as Budget Committee Chairman and Jeff Clabaugh seconded. There were no other nominations on the floor. The motion passed unanimously.

Linda LaRue nominated Tim Holtz as Budget Committee Vice-Chair and Jeff Clabaugh seconded. There were no other nominations on the floor. The motion passed unanimously.

Presentation of Budget Message

Superintendent Kevin Dinning read the 2023-2024 budget message to the budget committee and thanked Business Manager Kim Gilsdorf for her work on the budget.

Budget Review - Kim Gilsdorf, Business Manager

Kim began by reviewing the entire budget document with the Budget Committee in detail, pausing and allowing for questions.

Kim explained that the budget is built on an enrollment of 130 students and a State revenue estimate of 9.9 billion, but it could come in at 10.2 billion.

There were a few questions answered about property taxes, special education, bond funds and negotiations.

Action of Budget

a) Approve Tax Rate (<u>\$4.0342 per \$1,000 of assessed valuation</u>) and Budget Amount

Tim Holtz moved, and Linda LaRue seconded that the budget committee of the Ione School District approves taxes for the 2023-24 fiscal year at the rate of \$4.0342 per \$1,000 of assessed value for operating purposes in the general fund; and in the amount of \$865,000 for bonds; and approve the budget in the amount of \$30,424,944 for the entire operations of the District.

It is moved and seconded that the budget committee of the Ione School District approves taxes for the 2023-2024 fiscal year at the rate of \$4.0342 per \$1,000 of assessed value for operating purposes in the general fund; and in the amount of \$865,000 for bonds; and approve the budget in the amount of \$30,424,944 for the entire operations of the District.

The motion was unanimously approved.
