Dear Prairie Home Family,

As we work to keep students and staff safe during this pandemic, we will share as much information as possible with you, while still following legal and ethical privacy rules.

With conversations of the new variant of COVID-19 and schools around us seeing a spike in cases, I thought it would be important to send around some reminders of our protocols. We will continue to do extra cleaning. Our custodial staff will be using our disinfecting spray guns that we have used in the past to clean multiple surfaces. We have air purifiers in every room. We are double checking that we have hand sanitizer in every classroom as well.

We ask everyone to screen their students at home. If student is running a fever or feels sick, then please keep them home. Students should be wearing masks on school bus. Masks are recommended when distancing is not possible. If your student experiencing symptoms of COVID-19, then please seek guidance from the Cooper County Health Department or your medical provider, and ***please keep the student at home.***

Cooper Health Department will provide a vaccination clinic on Wednesday, December 1st, at 2:30pm. It is for any individual age 5 and up. If you would like your student to receive the vaccine, then you must attend the vaccination clinic with your student.

The District will continue to work closely with the Cooper County Health Department in their contact-tracing efforts as needed and will continue to do so with future cases.
