Dr. Shawn Judson, Superintendent

1. Welcome and Public Comment

Myiesha Majors, Chairperson, welcomed and thanked committee members for attending. No public comment shared.

2. Congratulation to our new AAPEAC Secretary, Nicole Edun *Myiesha Majors, Chairperson, introduced Nicole Edun.*

3. Breakout Room Team Builder

Nicole Edun, Secretary, asked everyone to share their name story (personal or traditional meaning, family connections, or origin of their name).

4. Fall Principal Meeting Debrief

Damita Walton, Director of Personnel/Pupil Services, shared the common themes for the September 2021 meetings. Representatives were encouraged to reach out to the principals to schedule winter meetings to plan for Black History Month.

Tawni Flot-Williams, Vice-Chairperson, shared the impact of her meeting with the principal and its impact on parent conferences.

Sueann Pitman, Educator, shared how the relationship between Tawni and the principal helped create the model for parent conferences.

Dr. Judson, Superintendent, also shared that the principal and AAPEAC representative meetings are a positive topic when he and Ms. Sprague meet with the principals.

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5. Update on Culturally Responsive Teaching & Learning

Jeannie Tavolazzi, Director of Instruction, reviewed the learning plan for teachers. She shared that the first Equity Cadre is working on a book study by Dr. Sharroky Hollie. She also reviewed district's Culturally Responsive Teaching and Learning (CCRTL) plan for 2021-22.

6. Presentation on i-Ready Assessments

David Ortiz, Instruction Coordinator Data & Assessment, explained that i-Ready is a state of the art diagnostic assessment on reading and math and shared that research shows i-Ready Diagnostic to be highly correlated with Smarter Balanced Assessments and an accurate predictor of Smarter Balanced results. He also reviewed the basic differences between i-Ready, a diagnostic assessment, and CAASPP, a summative assessment.

7. AAPEAC Innovation Funding

Tawni Flot-Williams, Vice-Chairperson, encouraged everyone to work with the principal to submit a proposal.

Damita Walton, Director of Personnel/Pupil Services, reminded everyone that the Innovation Funding proposal information is on the Etiwanda School District website under "How to Get Involved" AAPEAC.

Myiesha Majors, Chairperson, stated there is no deadline to submit a proposal; however, everyone is encouraged to submit 2-3 weeks prior to a meeting in order to add the proposal to the agenda.

8. AAPEAC Subcommittees

- a) Cultural Event Subcommittee Sue Ann Pittman stated that the subcommittee has not met.
- b) Academic Subcommittee Tracee Stewart stated they are working on a proposal for teacher training. Bridgette Peteet stated they are continuing work from last year, working with Personnel on staffing goals developed in 2020-21..
- c) Parent/Teacher Interaction Keisha Haylock stated that 2-3 questions focusing on parent/teacher interaction will be added to the LCAP survey.
- d) Family Engagement Corrie Blake and Jessica Lara stated there was a meeting and discussion for a non-Zoom alternate activity.

9. Closing

Myiesha Majors, Chairperson, shared that the September 2021 AAPEAC Voice was opened by 480 recipients, an increase of 145 readers from the May 2021 edition.
