Board Policy No. 3003: LOTTERY FUNDS

- A. The Governing Board shall determine the uses to which lottery funds received from the State will be put. Because amounts received from the California State lottery fluctuate from year to year, the Board shall not commit the receipt of future lottery funds for any purpose until such funds have actually been received. The Board shall establish funding priorities and approve all allocations within the parameters of law.

- B. The Board shall use lottery funds for supplemental and nonrecurring expenditures which support educational programs and activities.

- C. Lottery funds shall not be used to acquire real estate, build school facilities, finance research, or serve any other noninstructional purpose, such as those related to school maintenance, business and administrative operations. Products designed for both instructional and noninstructional purposes may be purchased with lottery funds only when they will be used to benefit an educational program or activity.

- D. The Superintendent or designee shall establish a separate account for the receipt and distribution of lottery funds.
