

Tiverton Middle School names National Geographic Bee winner


Sam Black is our Geography Champion! As a 6th-grade student at Tiverton Middle School Sam won the school competition of the National Geographic Bee on January 25th and a chance at a \$50,000 college scholarship. The school Bee, at which students answered questions on geography, was the first round in the 31st annual National Geographic Bee. Emily Pensak, grade 7, placed second, Silas Aguiar, grade 5, placed third, and Jacqueline Delcourt, grade 8, placed fourth.

Thousands of schools around the United States and in the five U.S. territories are participating in the 2019 National Geographic Bee. The school champions, including Sam, will take a qualifying test; up to 100 of the top scorers on that test in each state will then be eligible to compete in their state Geo Bee.


