- 1. LD 1858 Security and Roofing grant
 - a. This is currently on the Governor's Desk.
 - b. This grant may provide funding for roofing or school security
- 2. Electricity bill Richard Devries provided an analysis

 - b. Recommendation to look at the big motors in the ventilation systems.
