SCHOOL UPDATES:

School Functioning Updates and Priorities:

Winnisquam: Linda - do not have masking policy at Winnisquam, have a lot of Covid cases and absences students and staff, a lot of emotional stress

Franklin: Barb - masking is case by case/conditional- different in each school, kids and staff are tired of that. at highest had 25 cases in the district, down now to about dozen, seeing difficult behaviors all over - students/families/staff are all stressed. Counseling department is fully staffed.

• Promising Futures Grant: Barb Updated

To support MTSSB, defined as:

NH's Multi-Tiered System of Supports for Behavioral Health & Wellness (MTSS-B) Part of the larger children's system of care in NH, MTSS-B is a comprehensive system of social, emotional, and behavioral supports to promote student wellness and improve engagement in learning. MTSS-B's integrated delivery system depends on intentional collaboration between school districts and their community mental health and youth/family-serving partners. Based on the Interconnected Systems Framework, MTSS-B blends research-based school mental health practices and social-emotional learning with a tiered prevention framework that offers school wide social-emotional and behavioral programs at the universal level (Tier 1), targeted supports for at-risk students (Tier 2), and intensive, individualized services for the highest-need students (Tier 3).
