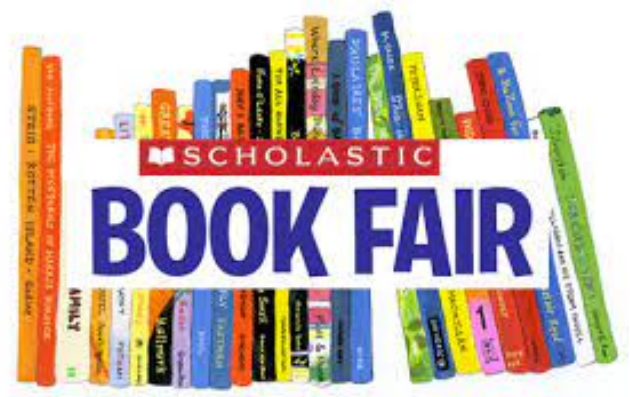

December 6th-13th



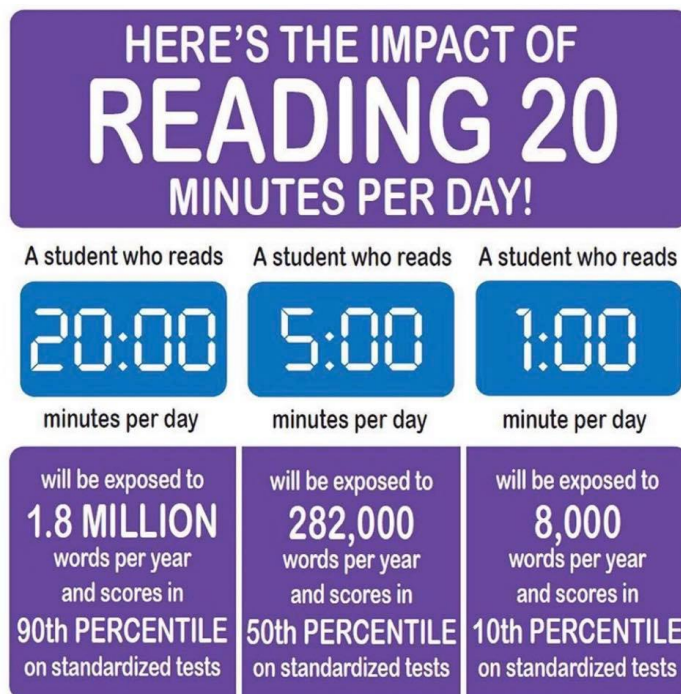
Make sure you take some time to come and see what amazing books we have to offer!!
