

Frequently Asked Questions regarding transportation to Northvale

1. Is there sufficient parking for all seniors and juniors if they drive themselves?

Yes, there is ample parking to accommodate both seniors and juniors if they choose to drive themselves.

2. If MS and HS students will be attending this location in Northvale on the same days and I have children in both, can I drop both children off at the earlier HS start time?

Yes. We have always made provisions for period 1 MS students being supervised in a location if they arrive early with a HS sibling. If we determine a program and schedule that would include both MS and HS grade levels at any one location, we would definitely include this in our planning.

3. If MS and HS students will not be attending this location Northvale together and I have children in both, I might need transportation for one of my children. How should I answer the survey?

Please select "I request transportation/busing for my child(ren)" for your child(ren) that could possibly need transportation. We are looking to obtain best estimates of the number of students needing transportation, so that we can properly contract with busing companies.

4. The email blast references Norwood while the survey references Northvale. Which one is it?

The facility we are seeking to lease is in Northvale on the border of Norwood, with a sister building around the corner in Norwood. The location to be used by students will be the one located in Northvale.

5. I will be able to drive most days, but not all days. Is busing available on an as-needed basis.
