

All parents, guardians, or other persons with lawful control of a student shall annually complete and sign registration forms. Where a parent or guardian states that he or she alone is legally responsible for the child or children and the other parent has limited educational rights regarding the child(ren), the building administrator shall require a certified court order delineating the parental and/or custodial rights of the parties involved. Without such a valid court order to the contrary, each parent or guardian shall be afforded the same rights of access to the student, student records, and educational decision-making regarding the student. A parent or guardian who is a registered sex offender shall be allowed on campus where permitted by terms of release or court order. Other sex offender parents may access to his or her child's records electronically or by mail, and teachers and campus administrators by telephone or by making an appointment with the campus principal, who shall ensure that the parent/guardian is at all times supervised by a District employee, if lawfully permitted on District property.
