

Home visits are a useful outreach tool for parents, administrators, teachers and staff to improve student achievement, ensure student safety and confirm understanding of and compliance with school district rules and procedures. Home visits may be necessary for several purposes including providing mandatory pre-kindergarten orientation visits, identifying needed wraparound services for students and families, assisting with students experiencing homelessness, verifying home addresses for registration purposes, as well as other academic or attendance purposes.

The Superintendent is authorized to adopt necessary administrative regulations for the various types of home visits and for the purpose of facilitating positive, appropriate and safe home visits. It is recommended that, when possible, home visits by District personnel be conducted by at least two District employees, or a District employee and an SFPS contracted employee.
