HONOR ROLL

At the conclusion of each semester grading period, an honor roll will be published for students in grades 7-12. Honor Roll listings will be by school grade, by categorical honor, in alphabetical order. Students will be categorized in the following:

- Highest Honors (96.00-100%)
- High Honors (92.50-95.99%)
- With Honors (87.00-92.49%)

All classes for which credit is granted will be included in determining honor roll status.

Honor roll will be considered directory information for purposes of the Family Education Rights and Privacy Act (FERPA). Any student may decline publication of his/her name on the honor roll by making a written request to the principal. If the student is under 18, a parent or guardian must cosign the request.
