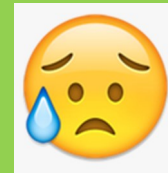
What is "Teen Dating Violence"

Frequent & demanded check in with "friend"
Changes in openness about plans & relationship
Extreme changes in appearance & clothing selections
Extreme mood swings, especially after contact with "friend"
Self harm behaviors
