School Board Meeting

November 8, 2000

The Stanley County School District, #57-1, Board of Education met in special session November 8, 2000, 5:30 P.M., in the study hall of the high school building with Charlene Foster, Gary Johnson, Mary Beth Fravel, Steve Brown and John Bucholz present. Also in attendance was Business Manager Kevin Merscheid. Visitors included Henry Kusters, Jerry Ehlers, Tony Mangan and Sara Hagen.
