 - Implement a grade appropriate nutrition education program that will develop an awareness of and appreciation for nutrition and physical activity throughout the curriculum;
 - 3. Enforce existing physical education requirements and engage students in healthy levels of vigorous physical activity;
 - Strive to improve the quality of physical education curricula and increase the training of physical education teachers;

- Not use food or beverages as rewards for academic, classroom, or sports performances;
- Establish class schedules and bus routes that do not directly or indirectly restrict meal access;
- 8. Provide students with ample time to eat their meals in pleasant cafeteria and dining areas:
- 9. Abide by the current allowable food and beverage portion standards;
- 10. Meet or exceed the more stringent of Arkansas' or the U.S. Department of Agriculture's (USDA) Nutrition Standards for reimbursable meals and a la' carte foods served in the cafeteria;
- 11. Restrict access to competitive foods as required by law and Rule;
- 12. Conform new and/or renewed vending contracts to the content restrictions contained in the Rules and reduce district dependence on profits from the sale of competitive foods.
- 13. Provide professional development to all district staff on the topics of nutrition and/or physical activity;
- 14. Utilize the School Health Index available from the CDC to assess how well the district is doing at implementing this wellness policy and at promoting a healthy environment for its students.
