## 2021-2022 Inclement Weather Guide for Nicholas County Schools

- Alternate Snow Route Days will be called when the main roads are clear. Staff reports to school on these days and students who are unable to safely travel to the alternate route should work on assignments from home. These days will count as an excused absence if school transportation is not provided for the scheduled bus route. Click the following link for 2021-2022 Alternate Snow Routes.
- 2 Hour Delay and 3 Hour Delay Schedules will be called when deemed necessary. All staff and students will report on the delayed schedule.
- The first 5 snow days will be counted from our Bank Time Schedule...Students and Staff do not report to school. Staff will not work from home and students will not be required to do assignments. These days do not have to be made up.
- The second 5 snow days will be counted from our Non-Traditional Instructional Day Schedule (NTID)...Staff will be required to report to school on a 2 or $\mathbf{3}$ hour delay. Students will remain home and be required to do NTID assignments and TEAMS Meetings. Superintendent reserves the right to also assign staff to work from home on severe inclement weather days. - The next 6 snow days will be counted as Outside School Environment Days, scheduled at the end of the school calendar for early out or used during the school year for inclement weather. Staff and Students do not report to school or have assignments. These days will not be made up.
- Students and Staff will begin making up days at the end of the school year starting with the $17^{\text {th }}$ snow day.
- NOTE: There are 5 Professional Learning Days built into the calendar, staff must work these days or take as a personal/sick day.
