## Strategies, Policies, and Procedures

JCSD is currently following the Masking order of the PA DOH while allowing parents to submit requests for exemption. JCSD will continue to distance students to the greatest extent possible.

JCSD will continue to instruct students on proper handwashing, ensuring that students and staff have access to facilities for the washing of hands. If soap and water are not readily available, use of a hand sanitizer that contains at least 60% will be made available.

JCSD will continue to clean high touch surfaces and operate the HVAC system for maximum circulation (weather permitting).

JCSD will report the number of positive cases and possible close contacts to the PA DOH weekly.

JCSD will consider CDC guidelines for people at risk of severe illness, people who need to take extra precautions, and other at-risk populations.
