



REFUND POLICY

Cancellations made prior to the second class may receive a full refund, less an \$8.00 service fee (on classes 3 days or less the refund will be prorated). No refunds will be given after the scheduled date of the second class. If a class is not filled or is cancelled, a full refund will be given. Refunds can take 2 weeks to process. A fee of \$35 will be assessed for returned checks.

WEATHER/CANCELLATION POLICY

Any class which does not have the required minimum number of enrollments is subject to cancellation. Individuals registered for a class which is cancelled will receive a full refund. Every attempt will be made to reschedule classes cancelled due to weather, instructor illness, etc. However, when circumstances prohibit rescheduling, classes will not be made up and no partial refunds will be given. 

Swim Class Descriptions

AQUA BABIES & TOTS(9 months to 4 yrs) Limit 15 per class.

Prerequisite: Must be accompanied by adult. All infants must wear swim diapers and should not eat 1 1/2 hours before class time. Water safety and enjoyment stressed &Learning through play &Singing songs and playing games.

Prerequisite: Should be comfortable in the water without a life jacket. We will be working on: Supported floating and kicking on front and back Intro to alternating arm action & turning over from front to back Water safety rules How to get help in an emergency Fundamentals of using a life jacket Reaching assists with and without equipment.

LEVEL 2 (5 yrs & older)

Prerequisite: Should be comfortable in the water without a life jacket and have instructor approval. We will be working on: Rhythmic breathing ♦ Combined stroke on front and back ♦ Turning over front to back and back to front ♦ Reaching and extension assists

LEVEL 3/4

Prerequisite: Children must be 42" to the chin. We will be working on: Increasing swimming skill competency Treading in deep water Continued work on backstroke, front crawl, breaststroke and kicks Practicing safety and rescue skills Jumping into deep water without a life jacket Diving from the side of the pool




