Begin review of Social Studies and Science curriculum resources that are aligned with standards.	Thank you for making the social studies adoption happen. We are finalizing our material needs and hopefully cutting the cost from the initial proposal.
Explicit Direct Instruction- Year two.	We are shifting our focus from EDI to AVID and MTSS for 2018-19.
Monitor EDI implementation in classrooms.	All formal observations and evaluations were completed. Although our focus is not EDI we will still look for these engagement strategies in our classrooms.

Continue to provide small group instructional support in ELA and math. After school	Bishop Elementary and ICSOS will begin our shift to MTSS this summer. We will continue to offer



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programs for bilingual support.	support programs to students next school year. We will be redesigning our daily schedule to better accommodate an intervention/enrichment period within the school day. We have decided to move forward with having Jacquie Carter facilitate a 2nd-5th grade math intervention. Michele and Elaina will be focused on Title 1 reading for all grades.
Teachers use formative data in PLCs to provide timely remediation.	MTSS will help us create a better system of collecting, organizing and analyzing data to help drive instruction. With a targeted enrichment/intervention time, data will be crucial in developing who should be in each level of remediation or enrichment and for how long.
Offer extended day opportunities for all students in grades 3-12.	Our enrichment activities went great this trimester. We would like to keep these opportunities going as long as the funding is available.
ELD summer program for EL students.	We will move forward with EL summer school this year (August).

I will continue to monitor enrollment over the summer. Some of our primary classes are quite large and we are very close to going over the our Class Size Reduction average (24). Our 4th grade classes will also be starting out with 33 in each classroom next year.
